

## End-of-Life Care, CPR, and Medical Futility: Clarifying Ethical and Legal Obligations in Acute Care

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In the acute care setting, we often ask families to make challenging decisions regarding their loved ones' preferences and choices for end of life care when these individuals can no longer make those decisions themselves. In this presentation we aim to outline fundamental concepts and misconceptions surrounding cardiopulmonary resuscitation ("CPR"), the administration and withdrawal of life-sustaining therapies, and the framework provided by regulatory bodies for medical professionals to approach these situations.
