DROP IN HOURS: WEDNESDAYS FROM 930-230PM, ALL WELCOME!

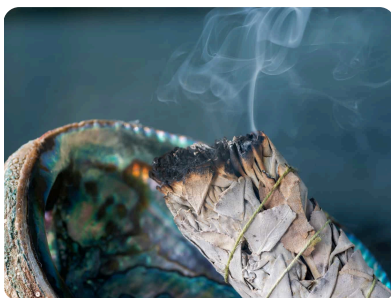
